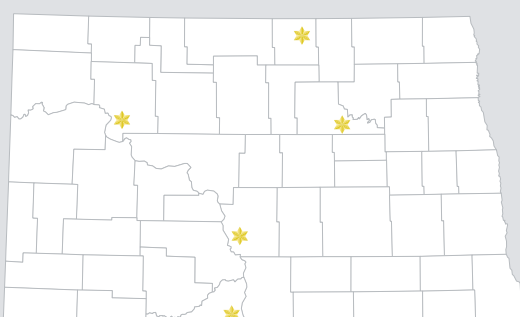

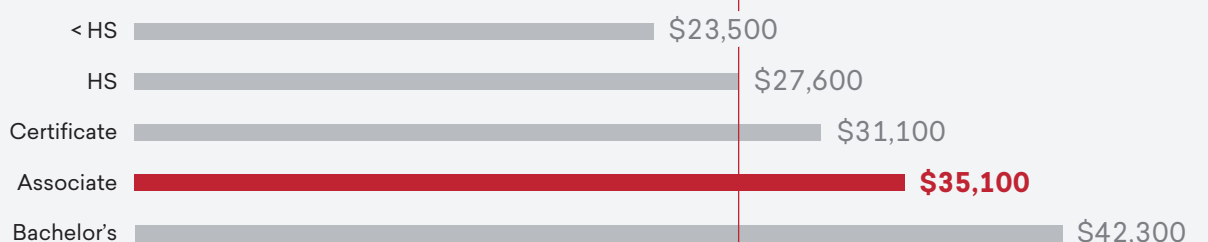

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

The average associate degree graduate from the NDATC will see an increase in earnings of **\$7,500** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in North Dakota.

Students gain \$3.40 in lifetime earnings

Taxpayers gain \$1.10 in added state revenue and social savings
